Niki is on the policing panel and also set up a Neighbourhood Watch scheme.

Road Danger and Safer Streets

Niki has reported unsafe road conditions, fly-tipping and moving traffic offences that could endanger life.

She has repeatedly raised residents' concerns about HS2 lorry routes and road closures in the meetings with HS2. She is disappointed that the council has not pushed hard enough.



Listening to you, and keeping you informed about what's going on in our area through her regular newsletters. In response to Niki's recent survey, lots of people said they were concerned about dog mess and litter. Match days at Taylor's Meadow were mentioned several times. Niki will be working harder to resolve the issues you raised.

Parking and transport.

After Niki started asking questions about the empty carpark, the council consulted on a new parking scheme. Niki says, "The council must rethink all day parking and drop the unreasonable charges in the car park – or the stop and shop scheme will add to the chaos."

Niki is a regular bus user and has been in touch with TfL asking for better services to the village and to make health provision more accessible.

Protecting our natural environment – a necessity for health.

Niki has lived in Harefield for 15 years. She loves music, the environment, animals and nature.

Niki holds a National Diploma in Horticulture. She has 7 City & Guilds Diplomas in various aspects of horticulture. She is an Amateur Entomologist and has a "first in the world" under her belt. She has been campaigning against HS2 since 2016.
